Broncos stay in Southern California

Staying close to home: Cal Poly Pomona (10-15 overall and 7-11 CCAA) remains in Southern California this weekend with matches against nationally-ranked Cal State L.A. on Friday and Cal State Dominguez Hills on Saturday. The Broncos have won two of their last three matches after losing four straight – three of which were against top 25 teams.

Golden Eagles rising: Cal State L.A. (18-7, 14-4) has won 9 of its last 10 matches and is coming off a 5-game win over CSUMB. The Golden Eagles won the season's first meeting – a 3-1 decision on Oct. 3 (26-28, 26-24, 25-11, 25-23). Senior **Elizabeth Diaz** led the Broncos with 13 kills and freshman **Lindsay Poulos** was 12-0-21 for a .571 attack percentage in the loss. Freshman **Diana Lake** (Covina) also had double digit kills with 10. CSULA holds the all-time series lead at 34-32.

Toros tales: The Toros enter the weekend (1-22, 1-15). Senior **Audrey Driscoll** fired a career-high six service aces and led the Broncos with 17 digs as CPP defeated Cal State Dominguez Hills 3-0 (25-12, 25-16, 25-18) on Oct. 2. The Broncos fired off an impressive .348 attack percentage

effort from a host of her Broncos. The Broncos own the all-time series vs. the Toros at 54-5. The Broncos have defeated CSUDH five straight times.

About Humboldt State: Cal Poly Pomona cruised to a 3-1 victory (25-16, 25-23, 22-25, 25-16) over Humboldt State in California Collegiate Athletic Association volleyball Friday night. The win improved the Broncos' record to 10-14 overall and 7-10 in California Collegiate Athletic Association matches. Humboldt State dropped its fifth straight, and is 7-18 overall and 3-14. **Elizabeth Diaz** and **Kristin McNeese** led Cal Poly Pomona, finishing with 14 and 10 kills, respectively. Setter **Jasmine Davis** finished with 36 assists and 15 digs, one short of **Audrey Driscoll**, who had a match-high 16. The Broncos fired a collective .316 in the opening game to set the tone for the victory. CPP threw down 15 kills with just three attack errors to win Game 1. Game 2 was tighter, but CPP again got the job done. HSU came back after intermission with a tight win, before the Broncos gained control in the final game. In Game 4, the Broncos grabbed a 20-6 lead and left little doubt in earning the game and match victory.

About Sonoma State: Cal Poly Pomona played its most inspired road match of the season and took nationally-ranked Sonoma State to the brink before losing 3-2 in California Collegiate Athletic Association volleyball Friday night. Sonoma State rallied from a 2-1 deficit to defeat Cal Poly Pomona in five sets on Senior Night at The Wolves' Den. Cal Poly Pomona jumped out to a 9-3 lead in the opening set before it forced Sonoma State to take its first timeout of the match. CPP held the Seawolves to just .089 hitting thanks to 4 1/2 total blocks by the Broncos and 12 digs by libero **Audrey Driscoll**. Sonoma State took control of Game 2 early and took the 7-2 lead forcing a Cal Poly Pomona timeout. The Broncos kept things close throughout the second frame, including a 22-21 score in favor of Sonoma State but three straight kills by Allyson Sather evened the match at one set apiece. After intermission, Cal Poly Pomona survived seven ties and as many lead changes to win Game 3 25-17 thanks to six kills by **Kristin McNeese** for the Broncos, who hit .286 in the set and held the Seawolves to just eight kills (.111 hitting percentage). Sonoma State went on a 11-5 run in Game 4 to finish the set, forcing the fifth and deciding set. The Seawolves had 12 kills in 25 attacks and just one error (.440) to earn Game 5 and the match. For Cal Poly Pomona, **McNeese** paced the Broncos with 15 kills and **Elizabeth Diaz** added 12. **Driscoll** finished with 25 digs and **Jasmine Davis** dealt 45 assists. **Taylr Kreutziger** had a game-high eight assisted blocks for CCP, which finished the night with 9.5 blocks.

Moving up the charts: Seniors **Jasmine Davis** and **Audrey Driscoll** have played integral roles during their careers at Cal Poly Pomona and have moved up the all-time charts in their specialty. **Davis** ranks 4th all-time in set assists (2,983) and has

named September's **Enterprise Athlete of the Month** at Cal Poly Pomona. She established a career-high 19 kills in the match against Sonoma State on Sept. 25 and leads the Broncos in kills (265) and kills/game (3.01). It was her first athlete of the month honor in her career.

Freshman production: **Lindsey Poulos** has been a standout performer for the Broncos in her initial season. The Los Altos native ranks fourth in blocks this week in CCAA overall games (.92/game) and 10th in league games (.81/game).

Meet the Coach: **Rosie Wegrich** (UCLA '75) is in her 18th season at the helm and her 34th year as a head coach on the collegiate level. She holds a 323-208 record at Cal Poly Pomona and owns a 652-467-10 record that includes stops at Minnesota and Arizona. She has taken nine Bronco teams to the NCAA Tournament.
