Otter Tales: CSUMB (12-18, 6-14) has won 4 of its last 7 matches and is coming off a 3-game loss vs. UCSD. The Broncos won the season's first meeting –a thrilling, come-from-behind victory. The

Broncos fired off 61 kills in the 17-25, 25-12, 22-25, 25-22, 16-14 victory. Three players reached double figures in kills with junior **Courtney Alberi** leading the way with 16 kills and just two errors. She finished with a .368 attack percentage. The Broncos lead the all-time series at 10-1 and have won the last five meetings.

Gator Notes: The Toros enter the weekend (19-9, 12-8) and own their biggest win of the year – a 3-1 win over nationally-ranked UCSD, but lost a 3-2 match the following night against CSU East Bay. Senior Elizabeth Diaz threw down 16 kills and sophomore Kristin McNeese (Torrance) added 10 kills, but host San Francisco State defeated the Broncos 3-1 for its first win in 13 meetings against the Broncos. The Broncos hold the all-time series lead at 25-6.

About Cal State L.A.: Cal Poly Pomona gave No. 21 Cal State Los Angeles all the Golden Eagles could handle in a 3-2 loss in California Collegiate Athletic Association volleyball Friday night. The Broncos grabbed a 2-0 lead, but CSULA rallied to win 21-25, 20-25, 25-19, 25-16, 15-8 in the Eagles Nest. Cal State L.A. (19-7, 15-4 CCAA) won for the 10th time in its last 11 matches. CPP is 10-16 and 7-12. Gabriela Bulawczyk led CSULA with 22 kills, 16 digs, two solo blocks and a hitting percentage of .463. Mary Laupepa tied a school record with nine service aces. **Elizabeth Diaz** and **Kristin McNeese** had 12 kills each for the Broncos, who lost their second consecutive five-set decision to a top-25 team. **Jasmine Davis** had 38 set assists and seven kills for the Broncos. Cal State L.A. had a 63-54 edge in kills and outhit the Broncos, .245-.219. The Broncos had a 9.5 – 7 advantage in blocks. Laupepa's nine aces gave the Golden Eagles a 9-4 edge in that department. The Broncos started quickly and grabbed the first two sets. Cal State L.A. closed the deficit to 18-17, but CPP scored the next three points to resume control. A kill by **Diaz** gave the Broncos the first set, 25-20. Cal State L.A. jumped out to an 8-4 lead in the second set, but Cal Poly Pomona rallied and took the lead for good at 14-13 after a kill by **Taylr Kreutziger**. The Broncos got back-to-back aces from **Lindsey Poulos** to open up a 24-16 lead and then ended the set at 25-20 after a kill by **Kreutziger**. After the intermission, the Golden Eagles came roaring back. Cal State L.A. opened up quick 10-5 lead and led comfortably throughout. The Golden Eagles raced out to a 16-5 lead in the fourth set with Laupepa serving for four aces in an 11-0 run that broke a 5-5 tie. Bulawczyk had five kills to help Cal State L.A. grab a 6-1 lead. The advantage grew to 8-1 and 9-3 before CSULA won the game and match.

About CSUDH: One night after a disappointing five-game loss to No. 21 Cal State Los Angeles, the Cal Poly Pomona Broncos shook aside any lingering disappointment with a resounding 3-0 win over host Cal State Dominguez Hills in California Collegiate Athletic Association play Saturday night. The Broncos earned a 25-11, 26-24, 25-18 victory and improved to 11-16 overall and 8-12 in the CCAA. The Toros dropped to 1-26 and 1-19. The Broncos took charge early, taking a 7-3 lead on a Karissa Lagmay putaway before running off 18 of the next 26 points in the 25-11 Game 1 win. CPP led throughout Game 2, but the Toros came from behind to lead 23-22. But three kills -- two from Taylr Kreutziger and one from Kristin McNeese -- down the stretch gave CPP a 2-0 lead entering intermission. CPP pulled away early in Game 3 with a 19-8 lead on a McNeese blast, the first of four-consecutive points on the serve of Lindsey Poulos. Lagmay led all players with 14 kills on .440 hitting. As a team, the Broncos outhit the Toros .284 to .137.

Freshman production: Lindsey Poulos has been a standout performer for the Broncos in her initial season. The Los Altos native ranks third in blocks this week in CCAA overall games (.91/game) and T8th in league games (.8/game). She also ranks 10th in CCAA matches only in hitting percentage (.282).

Meet the Coach: Rosie Wegrich (UCLA '75) is in her 18th season at the helm and her 34th year as a head coach on the collegiate level. She holds a 324-209 record at Cal Poly Pomona and owns a 653-468-10 record that includes stops at Minnesota and Arizona. She has taken nine Bronco teams to the NCAA Tournament.
