Broncos complete season 10-10-0

The Schedule:

Regular season completed

A pair against the Coyotes: Cal Poly Pomona completed its season Sunday with a solid 4-3 2-overtime victory over rival Cal State San Bernardino on Sunday in Pomona. The Broncos were led by senior **Mary Carroll's** four-goals that tied the school record shared with four others.

Ten victories: Cal Poly Pomona finished 10-10-0 overall and 6-10-0 in CCAA play. The 10 victories are the Broncos' most since going 10-8-1 in 2003 and thus, the most during coach **Isabelle Harvey's** four seasons. Sunday's victory over Cal State San Bernardino was its third 2 OT win this season.

Way to close the door, Mary: Senior **Mary Carroll** (Upland) ended her Bronco career in a storybook fashion Sunday, **tying a school record with four goals** in Sunday's 2 OT victory. **Carroll** shares the school record with four others including 1999 NCAA Player of the Year **Ruth Van't Land**, who was in attendance at Sunday's game. **Carroll finished the season with nine goals, five assists and 23 points – all team highs.**

10-0 overall and 6-10 in the CCAA. The Coyotes completed the regular season 10-8-2 and 9-5-2. **Carroll** put CPP on the board in the 12th minute when he drove up front after receiving the ball from senior **Andrea Salerno** and she pushed the ball past the left side of Coyotes GK Laura Lyons. **Carroll's** second came in the 27th minute on an unassisted goal. She drove the ball right down the middle and placed it over Lyon's head. The Coyotes answered with one of their own when Kristina Gomez scored her eighth goal of the season and second on the weekend series at the 42nd minute mark. Melissa Castillo got the ball to her teammate and Gomez went in all along against Broncos GK **Nakisha Gutierrez**. After halftime, **Carroll** gave CPP a 3-1 advantage in the 68th minute. Teammate **Valerie Strawn** drove on the left side and found **Carroll**, who had an opening on the right and scored. Two minutes later, Jenna Sanchez scored her first goal of the year off a corner kick from teammate Kelsey Gudgeon. CSUSB's Ashley Salas tied the game at 3-3 when she received a pass from Lindsey Witz and scored. **Gutierrez** earned the victory for CPP with two saves. CPP out-shot the Coyotes 21-12 and had 13 SOG to CSUSB's five.

Moving up the charts: The four goals from **Mary Carroll** on Sunday moved the Upland native up the all-time career scoring charts in a big-time way. She completed her career second in goals with 32, third in points (75) and third in shots (180) and ranks among all-time greats at Cal Poly Pomona.

Friday's game: Sophomore Kristina Gomez' scored the game's only goal as Cal State San Bernardino defeated Cal Poly Pomona 1-0. The Coyotes earned the goal just 9:46 into the match when junior Unity Beddingfield sprinted with the ball along the near sideline, then struck a cross that was collected by Melissa Lynn Castillo, who passed back across the front of the box to the on-rushing Gomez, who one-timed the ball inside the near post. CSUSB's defense limited Cal Poly Pomona to just seven shots and only three that required a save by senior goalkeeper Laura Lyons. Two of the Broncos' SOG were by **Andrea Salerno** and the third by **Carolyn Rubendall**.

Sunday's game: Senior **Mary Carroll** made sure her Cal Poly Pomona career ended with a flourish. The Upland forward scored a career high and tied a school record with four goals – and delivered the game-winner on a penalty kick – as the host Broncos upset the Cal State San Bernardino Coyotes 4-3 in double overtime before 383 on a warm, fall afternoon in Southern California. The victory was huge as Carroll delivered the winner in the game's 108th minute. CSUDH advanced anyway with a victory over UC San Diego on Sunday. A hand ball was called on the Coyotes in the second OT and **Carroll** was handed the responsibility of the penalty kick. She made sure her final SOG in her career was a good one and the Broncos ended the 2009 campaign 10-
